The activity schedule is listed below. Send the students according to the schedule.



Note: Students of primary classes who use school transportation can avail the senior bus trip for Extra Curricular Activities. Kindly refer to **Hand Book Page: no. 41, 42 and 43** for bus timings. The payment for **one Extra Curricular Activity is Rs. 5000/- per annum**. The students can opt for two activities provided there is no clash of days. Only on payment of the fees, the students will be permitted to take up the ECA.
